

The **CAN.recall** app comes with two sets of suggested question decks:

- **Initial Surgical Consult**
- **Initial Oncology Consult**

Review the question decks to choose which questions are appropriate for your consultation. Press on the Questions tab at the bottom of the page. You can add your own questions to the deck but keeping your list to about 10-15 questions ensures that your doctor will have sufficient time to answer them.

You can create your individual question deck by following these instructions:

1. Press the 'Questions' tab at the bottom of this screen and press the  button at the top right hand corner.
2. To choose one of the suggested question decks select 'Copy Existing'. Or 'New Empty Set' to create your own from scratch.
3. Select the appropriate question deck, give the deck a name and add a description e.g. Name: 'Consult with Dr Smith' Description: 'Follow up and check scan results'. Tap on the  'create' button in the top right hand corner to save this new deck.
4. To edit, select the  icon to the right of your new deck.
5. Select the circle button to the left of the question, a tick will appear in the circle. Press  'Delete' from bottom of the screen. This will delete all selected questions.
6. Tap on a question to choose  'Prioritise'  'Unprioritise'. Prioritised questions appear first in your question deck. Your first question should always be the one that asks permission for **CAN.recall** to be used during the consultation.
7. Tapping on the  icon allows you to edit a question.
8. To add your own custom questions, select the  'Add question' icon on the bottom right hand corner of the screen
9. Choose the section where you would like this question to appear from the scroll down list. Sections enable you to group questions about a certain topic. E.g. results or treatment types. You can also 'Add Section' or 'Remove Section' by pressing on the appropriate buttons at the bottom on the main Question Deck edit screen.
10. Create your question and press on the  'save' icon in the top right hand corner of the screen.
11. Once you have created your custom Question Deck you can select it at the beginning of your consultation and press the  record button to begin the recording. Both your questions and the doctors' answers are recorded.
12. Swipe to the left to advance to the next question or press the  'Next' button. Swipe to the right or press the  "previous" button to return to the previous question.
13. When your consultation is over simply tap the record button again and you'll be prompted to stop recording. You can then give that recording a title and to add any notes to help you identify it in the future. All recordings are automatically timestamped to help with this too. When you're done press OK and the recording is complete.

## How to use **CAN.recall** – Recordings

Once a consultation has taken place, it is possible to replay the discussion via the 'Recordings' tab. Each recording is date and time stamped and may be accessed at any time. You can give each recording a title and description and then press the 'Save' icon on the top right hand corner. You can edit or delete recordings at any time by selecting the  icon on the recording and then editing the details or selecting 

## How to use **CAN.recall** – Daily Journal

The Daily Journal works similarly to the Question Decks but without the structure of set questions. It is designed to allow you to record your thoughts, feelings and experiences like an audio diary. The recordings are saved to the same tab as your consultation recordings and can be edited and deleted in the same way as described above.

Press the  record button and start talking. When you are done, press  to go the next question. Once you are finished recording in your Daily Journal, press the 'Save' icon in the top left corner.
